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NRC to Conduct Pre-Decisional Enforcement Conference via Webinar on Special Inspection at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission will meet with representatives of Southern California Edison Co., on Jan. 24 to discuss preliminary findings of a Special Inspection it conducted at the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station following an Aug. 3 fuel-loading incident. The San Clemente, Calif., plant is owned by Southern California Edison and permanently shut down in 2013.

The meeting will be held from 2-5 p.m., Central Time at the NRC's Region IV office at 1600 E. Lamar Blvd., Arlington, Texas. It is open to public observation and will be broadcast via webinar. NRC officials will answer questions submitted via the Internet from the public following the business portion of the meeting.

No decision on the final safety significance of the findings identified in a Nov. 28 [inspection report](#) or any additional NRC actions will be made at the conference. That decision will be announced at a later date.
