Since the facility is scheduled for a trial run in April, and the evacuation plan is, as yet, not denosited in the designated location, (Salem County Library) said start-un is endangering the lives of the people of Salem County, and Federal guidelines are not being followed.

I therefore request a postponement until every precaution. has been made to ensure the safety of the residents in this area.
