FOR KENNECOTT URANIUM CO. SOURCE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. SUA-
1350

Dear Ms. Killebrew:

This letter is to inform Kennecott Uranium Company (Kennecott) that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is cancelling and returning the financial assurance instruments Kennecott provided to the NRC with respect to Kennecott's Source Materials License No. SUA-1350 for its Sweetwater Uranium Project.

Kennecott is no longer required to maintain financial assurance with respect to this NRC license as Wyoming (WY), now an Agreement State, has regulatory authority over the site. By letter dated January 14, 2019, WY has indicated that it has obtained satisfactory financial assurance for the site (Agencywide Document Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML19025A096). Therefore, NRC is now cancelling and returning the financial assurance instruments that were provided to NRC for this facility.

The financial assurance instruments that Kennecott provided in connection with this license was a surety bond issued by Fidelity and Deposit Corporation of MD and a standby trust agreement issued by Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. The surety bond, including amendments, and the standby trust agreement have been cancelled and are being returned to Kennecott at this time.
