In accordance with 10 CFR 50.80, 10 CFR 50.90 and 10 CFR 72.50, Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee, LLC and Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (collectively referred to as Entergy) and NorthStar Nuclear Decommissioning Company, LLC (NDC) and NorthStar Vermont Yankee, LLC (collectively referred to as NorthStar) requested consent approving the transfer of the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station Renewed Facility Operating License No. DPR-28 and the transfer of the generally licensed Vermont Yankee Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation, from Entergy to NorthStar. The transfer Order was approved on October 11, 2018 1, 2017 (Reference 1) and the conforming license amendment was issued on January 11, 2019 to reflect the direct transfer of these licenses for Vermont Yankee (Reference 2).

As a result of the completed license transfer, attached is a signed original Amendment No. 14 to Indemnity Agreement No. B-49 for Vermont Yankee.

This letter contains no new regulatory commitments.

AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. B-49  
AMENDMENT NO. 14

Effective JAN 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019, Indemnity Agreement No. B-49, between Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc., Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee, LLC, and the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission, dated November 30, 1970, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

The names "Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc., and Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee, LLC" are deleted wherever they appear in the indemnity agreement.




