Dear Amy Ramsey,

This is in reference to your letter received January 30, 2019, submitting financial assurance for Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 19-10306-01, Docket No. 03004552. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

- 1. In the key assumptions section, the estimated cost listed is based on 2017 dollars spent on a MARSSIM survey performed by a contractor. The most significant cost for the self-shielded irradiators was also based on 2017 cost. The submitted cost estimate needs to be submitted in what decommissioning your facilities costs in today's dollars. Please state that the cost estimate is accurate for 2019 costs or provide adjustments to estimate the cost of decommissioning today.
- 2. In the key assumptions, you state that no travel or equipment rental costs were used in the estimate since it is assumed that work will be done by ECBC personnel. In NUREG-1757, Volume 3, Rev. 1, "Consolidated Decommissioning Guidance Financial Assurance, Recordkeeping, and Timeliness," section A.3.1, it states, "The site-specific cost estimate required for a DFP must assume that the work will be performed by an independent third party and should represent the licensee's best approximation of all direct and indirect costs of decommissioning its facilities under routine facility conditions." Please perform the calculation as if an independent third party was performing the decommissioning.
- 3. For all future submittals, please include the date of the calculation. It is difficult referencing the calculation without a date.
- 4. The following buildings were included in the previous decommissioning cost estimate performed in May 2015 that was not included in this cost estimate: E-2371, E-3334, E3831, E-5325, E-3607, E-3942, E-5604, and E-5951. Please state why these buildings are no longer included in the cost estimate.
- 5. The radiological square footage of the buildings has changed since the May 2015 submittal. Please provide a statement why these amounts have changed.
- 6. The totals on the Unsealed and Sealed Radioactive Materials Decommissioning Surveys, appear to be incorrect. The total Rad Square Feet should be 106104, the total number of wipes should be 1680. The scan cost per building total would be \$37, 646, Cost of Wipe Tests would be \$13154, and cost of Direct Measurements \$4620. For the Sealed Only Source Decommissioning Surveys, Table Scan cost per Building total should be \$5720, 520 wipes, and \$4082. Please review your tables and calculations, make corrections and resubmit.
- Section A.3.2 of NUREG-1757, Vol. 3, Rev. 1, states, "Licensees who use DFPs
 must specify the means (i.e., the method and frequency) by which they will
 periodically adjust their cost estimates and associated funding levels over the life of

their facilities." Please provide this statement.
