1. Animal studies, instrument calibration, and in-vitro studies. Include the types and quantities of materials used in addition to the medial uses already described;
2. Approving new uses, new facilities, or new equipment;
3. Performing each of the duties listed in Sections 8.7.1 and 8.7.2 of NUREG-1556, Vol. 7, Rev.1, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses, Program-Specific Guidance About Academic, Research and Development, and Other Licenses of Limited Scope."
