Part 800, the staff of the Indiana State Historic Preservation Officer ("Indiana SHPO") has conducted an analysis of the materials received on February 1, 2019, for the above indicated project in Jefferson County, Indiana.

Thank you for the Environmental Assessment (EA). It is our understanding that the proposed amendment and exemption to Army license SUB-1435, License Condition 9 will not involve any demolition, construction, or ground disturbing activities. We have no additional comments.

Our office looks forward to assisting Jefferson Proving Grounds with any future reviews. It is our understanding that the management of the property in regard to cultural resources will follow the property's ICRMP (2011).
