In accordance with 10 CFR 50.83(b), Duke Energy Florida, LLC (DEF), submitted a request for approval to remove a portion of the site from the Crystal River Nuclear Plant (CR3) Part 50 license (License No. DPR-72) (Reference 1). Specifically, DEF requested approval to remove the nonimpacted survey units from its Part 50 license in accordance with 10 CFR 50.83(b), "Release of part of a power reactor facility or site for unrestricted use".
