Dear Mr. Kellogg,

This is in reference to your financial assurance submitted in letter dated January 3, 2019, for Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 44-00728-13, Docket No. 03013022. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. 10 CFR 30.35(e) requires in part, that each decommissioning funding plan must contain: a description that includes the means for adjusting cost estimates and associated funding levels periodically over the life of the facility; and an adjustment as necessary to account for changes in costs. Please provide the means for adjusting cost estimates and associated funding levels periodically over the life of the facility (i.e. What method you will use to determine your decommissioning costs in the future).
2. The Certification of Financial Assurance dated December 19, 2018, as well as Appendix B of your decommissioning funding plan, did not accurately reflect the amount of material on your license. You may either send in a new Certification of Financial Assurance or state that we can still use the Certification of Financial Assurance dated June 8, 2015.
3. Your letter dated January 3, 2019, used our previous address at 475 Allendale Road. Please update all your records so this does not happen in the future. We have been located at 2100 Renaissance Blvd, Suite 100, King of Prussia, PA 19406 since May 7, 2012.
