

Analysis of Indeterminate Exercise Outcomes

Year	Number of Indeterminate Exercises	Summary
2006	4	These exercises were indeterminate due to: excessive safety or administrative holds; insufficient exercise control; or extreme malfunctions of exercise simulation systems.
2007	5	These exercises were indeterminate due to insufficient exercise control and/or administrative holds.
2008	4	These exercises were indeterminate because of insufficient exercise control and/or administrative holds.
2009	4	These exercises were indeterminate because of insufficient exercise control or excessive administrative holds.
2010	4	These exercises were indeterminate because of drill artificialities, insufficient exercise control, responder actions, and/or safety concerns for the exercise participants.
2011	2	These exercises were indeterminate because of drill artificialities and exercise control issues.
2012	2	These exercises were deemed indeterminate because of site controller training and controller performance failures.
2013	2	These exercises were deemed indeterminate because of site controller training and controller performance failures.
2014	1	This exercise was deemed indeterminate because the licensee failed to identify in their protective strategy the location of a responder that had been planned and practiced, resulting in the neutralization of adversaries.
2015	4	These exercises were deemed indeterminate because site responders neutralized adversaries using practices unanticipated by the design of the protective strategy, site responders' demonstration of use-of-force was inconsistent with the licensees' protective strategy, exercise controllers failed to control drill artificialities, or because of anomalies with the control of the exercise and performance related to the sites' protective strategy implementation.
2016	1	This exercise was deemed indeterminate because of significant controller performance issues. Specifically, the licensee failed to properly control the exercise, which resulted in the NRC inspection team's inability to assess the licensee's capability to implement its protective strategy.
2017	0	
2018	1	This exercise was indeterminate because of drill artificialities and exercise control issues.
