LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that **Argus Energy, LLC** ("Argus"), a Kentucky limited liability company, hereby constitutes and appoints **Larry D. In no event shall persons relying on this Power of Attorney be required to ascertain the authority of Argus' attorney-in-fact to act hereunder, and all persons dealing with said attorney-in-fact shall be entitled, in the absence of actual knowledge of revocation, to rely upon the authority of such person, and the acts of such person shall bind Argus and acquit persons dealing with my said attorney-in-fact to the same extent as if Argus had been acting in its own behalf.
