Nuclear Regulatory Commission

On behalf of the Concerned Citizens for Lacey Coalition, we are requesting Lacey township (Ocean County) New Jersey be considered as one of the locations in a series of meeting locations as it develops a report identifying best practices for the establishment and operation of local community advisory boards in areas with decommissioning nuclear power plants.

It has been indicated, the federal agency expects to hold a minimum of 10 public meetings with host states and communities within the emergency planning zone of nuclear power plant, as well as existing local community advisory boards. Stakeholders wishing to submit comments on where a meeting should be held for the Oyster Creek Generating Station must do so by April 17.

Oyster Creek Nuclear Plant, once one of the largest employers in Ocean County and the nations oldest operating commercial nuclear power plant, was permanently taken offline in September 2018. With Exelon

Corp seeking to sell the decommissioning to Holtec International (License Transfer Agreement), we think the formation of such panels will serve as a valuable communications conduit for the Lacey citizens in standing regarding decommissioning of the Oyster Creek Nuclear Plant. We believe our Lacey Township community would benefit from a meeting.
