Chris,

Thanks for reaching out. After our last discussion, I left with the impression that you would send us the written list of RAI's. We would like to review them. After we receive that list then we would reply with the intent to suspend review of the scaling factor report with the caveat that we may want to pick that review back up if guidance or regulations are revised that result is disposal sites using the activities for TC-99 and I-129 that are derived from LLDs as real numbers for their disposal site inventory.

The suspension of the review is based on the fact that Clive and WCS are using any activities for these two nuclides that are manifested using LLDs as a zero. So the driver behind having a more accurate scaling factor is not really there. However if new guidance changes this practice, then I would have to go to my membership and determine the priority on responding to your RAIs. In order to do that I will need to see the RAI's so I can estimate the scope of and resources needed to respond with the requested information.

Does that match your recollection?
