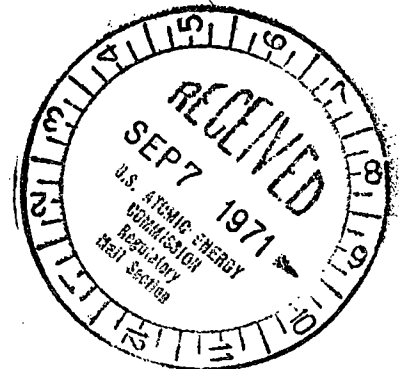

Dear Mr. Collins:

Our operating staff for Surry is continuing in preparation for AEC written examinations that are now scheduled to be administered on January 4 and 5, 1972.

We have established with you the eligibility of candidates for licensing in my letter of October 22, 1970 and your reply of November 3, 1970. Due to attrition, three of the approved applicants should be removed for licensing consideration:

- Mr. R. H. Dodge

To enable you to evaluate additional licensing candidates to supplement our Surry staff, we are enclosing the resumes of five men who will be seeking an AEC Cold Reactor Operator License for Surry I.

These men are now enrolled in a three-month on site nuclear training program with the other licensing candidates, and I would appreciate your comments regarding their eligibility to qualify for cold licensing.
