In NRC-2019-000233, you requested records relating to the installation, presence, and abatement of asbestos-containing materials and products, including any complaints or claims relating to, and records identifying sellers, manufacturers or suppliers of, asbestos, at the following locations: (a) Nine Mile Point Power Plant, Scriba NY, from 1970-1980; (b) James A. Fitzpatrick Nuclear Power Plant, Oswego, NY, from 1970-1980; and (c) Niagara Mohawk Steam Station, Oswego, NY from 1971 (sic).

In NRC-2019-000236, you requested records relating to the installation, presence, and abatement of asbestos-containing materials and products, including any complaints or claims relating to, and records identifying sellers, manufacturers or suppliers of, asbestos, at the following locations: (a) Ravenswood Powerhouse, Long Island City, NY, from 1960-1990; (b) Astoria Powerhouse, Astoria, NY, from 1960-2000; (c) Waterside Powerhouse, Manhattan, NY, from 1960-1970; and (d) Hellgate Powerhouse, Bronx, NY, from 1960-1970.

In NRC-2019-0001237, you requested records relating to the installation, presence, and abatement of asbestos-containing materials and products, including any complaints or claims relating to, and records identifying sellers, manufacturers or suppliers of, asbestos, at the following location: American Cyanamid, Linden, NJ, from 1948-1950.

We reached out to the offices of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR), Nuclear Material Safety & Safeguards (NMSS), and Region I (RI) to search for any records responsive to your request. However, no responsive records were located by the aforementioned offices. Nor did our search of ADAMS, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's official recordkeeping system turn up any responsive records. We note that, with the exception of the Nine Mile and Fitzpatrick plants, the others are not nuclear power plants that are, or were, regulated by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission or its predecessor, the Atomic Energy Commission.
