I have enclosed a copy of the signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research (NRC/RES) and the U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Nuclear Energy (DOE/NE), last renewed in 2014, on Cooperative Nuclear Safety Research. The MOU, which was specified to remain in force for a period of 5 years, will expire on May 1, 2019.
