Greetings:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, I am requesting the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) produce **before** the scheduled webinar on March 25, 2019, all records of communications from November 29, 2018 to present between any agent, officer or employee of Southern California Edison and any agent, officer or employee of the NRC regarding the subject matter of the March 25, 2019 meeting: the NRC's "enforcement decisions regarding the Special Inspections conducted by the NRC to evaluate an August 3, 2018 incident involving a loaded spent fuel storage canister that was misaligned and became stuck on a metal flange while being lowered into a storage vault."

I am asking to expedite this records request because the meeting is scheduled for next Monday (03/25), less than a week away. These records are critical to understanding the August 3rd incident as well as the on-going safety violations that have occurred at San Onfore. The public has a right to be kept abreast of the actions the NRC has taken to regulate the nuclear site, and these records can be made easily available to the public on the NRC's web page created for Category 3 meetings such as the March 25th webinar.

I am asking these records be produced **by March 23, 2019**, otherwise I will be forced to seek immediate judicial relief to resolve this issue. I am willing to pay any costs or fees associated with this records requests, if the costs or fees exceed \$1500 please notify me. Also please include my partner mseverson@amslawyers.com in all future communications. Thank you for working on this matter promptly.
