On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your letter of April 17, 2019, requesting that the NRC hold a public meeting near the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS) to help inform the NRC's work on identifying best practices for the establishment and operation of local decommissioning community advisory boards under the Nuclear Energy Innovation and Modernization Act (NEIMA). Over the next several weeks, the NRC staff will evaluate the requests that have been received in response to the NRC's recent *Federal Register* notice, using the direction provided in NEIMA regarding selection of meeting locations.
