The following information was obtained from the licensee via email:

"On May 11, 2019 at 0900, a healthy Olive Ridley sea turtle was recovered from the plant's intake canal. The turtle was tagged and released unharmed per our sea turtle protocol and with concurrence from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWCC). The FWCC was contacted on May 11, 2019 at 0920.

"This non-emergency notification is being made pursuant to the requirements of Section 4.1 of the St. Lucie Units 1 and 2 Environmental Protection Plans to promptly report the unusual occurrence of a protected species. Olive Ridley sea turtles are not normally found in the North Atlantic, making this capture an unusual occurrence."
