Enclosed is an application, dated April 15, 2019, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from Edlow International Company as Agent for PT Industri Nuklir Indonesia, for amendment No. 02 to XSNM3768/01. The license presently authorizes the export of 180 kilograms (kg) of low-enriched uranium, in the form of broken metal to be used for medical isotope production at the GA Siwabessy Research Reactor, and target fabrication at the PT INUKI, located in Indonesia.

The purpose of the amendment is to add The Center for Nuclear Fuel Technology as an additional ultimate consignee and Secured Transportation Services, LLC as an additional U.S. party to the export.

Assurances from Indonesia that the material will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of an agreement for cooperation are required. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.

Please note that the applicant has requested an expedited review of this application in order to ship this material in June 2019, to meet various required Indonesian deadlines.
