I believe I am a "stakeholder" as a US citizen residing within the Vermont Yankee emergency planning zone in southern Vermont.

Please note also that I have standing as director of an organization, Brattleboro Common Sense, which promoted legislation concerning the Vermont Yankee reactor. The legislation, EMDOVY, advocated a legislative study of a legal theory for closing VY because of its danger to the economy and was approved by plebiscite in Brattleboro and submitted to the Vermont Office of Legislative Council. Brattleboro Common Sense is also headquartered within the VY zone.

I trust that for one or both of these capacities the NRC will look favorably on my request that the next hearing under docket be held within the VY emergency planning zone. Although VY is currently being decommissioned, many people in this region are still interested in the matter.
