As Chair of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Nuclear Decommissioning Citizens Advisory Panel (NDCAP), I am writing to request that you and your colleagues consider and include the NDCAP in your preparations, activities and meetings as part of your efforts to prepare the congressionally mandated report on best practices for local community boards to provide advice on nuclear decommissioning projects.

The Commonwealth created the NDCAP two years in advance of the announced shutdown of the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station (PNPS). By law, the NDCAP represents all of the stakeholders involved in the decommissioning of PNPS.
