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Loren,

I believe I mentioned to you on our last call that the President signed the enclosed bill on Jan 14. I have been assigned the Section 108 task, which requires NRC to hold at least 10 NRC Category III public meetings around the country to obtain comments from the public and develop a best practices report for citizens advisory boards/engagement panels (CAB/CEP) for the Congress within 18 months.

Obviously, PGE sponsors the Humboldt Bay and Diablo Canyon citizens engagement panels. We are just getting started on this task and want to begin discussions on possible

meetings later this spring/summer. Unfortunately, the law specifically says we must hold NRC meetings and does not give us the latitude to attend a scheduled CAB/CEP meeting. The public meetings would be similar to the PSDAR/LTP meetings where we have a short presentation and then listen to comments from the public. My initial thoughts would be to schedule our meeting the same evening with a CAB/CEP as not to impose on the members, but I am not sure this can be done.

Can you provide me with the PGE contact for each of the panels so we begin a dialogue to schedule meetings?

If possible, I am hoping that to obtain the following info: (1) charter information for the community group; (2) contact information for the lead member of the community group; (3) schedule information for any upcoming meetings.
