On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your letter of May 13, 2019, requesting that the NRC hold a public meeting in Plymouth, Massachusetts to help inform the NRC's work on identifying best practices for the establishment and operation of local decommissioning community advisory boards under the Nuclear Energy Innovation and Modernization Act (NEIMA).
