On February 28, 2019, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed the onsite portion of an inspection at Cooper Nuclear Station. On April 17, 2019, the NRC inspectors discussed the results of this inspection with Mr. K. Dia, Acting Vice President-Nuclear and Chief Nuclear Officer, and other members of your staff. The results of this inspection are documented in the enclosed report.

NRC inspectors documented two findings of very low security significance (Green) in this report. The findings involved violations of NRC requirements. The NRC is treating these violations as non-cited violations consistent with Section 2.3.2 of the Enforcement Policy.

If you contest the violations or significance of these non-cited violations, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator, Region IV; the Director, Office of Enforcement; and the NRC resident inspector at Cooper Nuclear Station.

If you disagree with any cross-cutting aspect assignment in this report, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your disagreement, to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, DC, 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator, Region IV; and the NRC resident inspector at Cooper Nuclear Station.
