Good afternoon Ms. Luna,

I have reviewed the licensee's request dated 4/19/19 to name a new RSO on the subject NRC license.

In accordance with 10 CFR 35.50 (c)(2), the proposed RSO is an AU named on an NRC license for 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200 and must meet the requirements in paragraph (d).

10 CFR 35.50 (d) states "Has training in the radiation safety, regulatory issues, and emergency procedures for the types of use for which a licensee seeks approval. This training requirement may be satisfied by completing training that is supervised by a Radiation Safety Officer, an Associate Radiation Safety Officer, authorized medical physicist, authorized nuclear pharmacist, or authorized user, as appropriate, who is authorized for the type(s) of use for which the licensee is seeking approval."

In conclusion, I need a signed and dated letter (letter signed by current RSO or management) stating that Ralph Duman MD received training in the radiation safety, regulatory issues, and emergency procedures for the use of 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200 material.
