Why on earth does Florida Power & Light want to extend the operating life of the nuclear reactors at the Turkey Point Nuclear Power Plant which is polluting the surface water connected to Biscayne and the aquifer that supplies drinking water for millions in the South Florida area? Is your goal to harm this environment and peoples' health??

I vehemently OPPOSE Florida Power & Light's plan to extending the operating life of this aging plant for 30 more years.

Another issue is Turkey Point's geographic location which makes it particularly susceptible to sea level rise and storm surge impacts. Under even the most optimistic sea level rise projections, Turkey Point and parts of the cooling canals will be inundated by 2040, 13 years before the end of the reactors' operating life if this proposal is approved. Putting your head in the sand and pretending climate change doesn't exist is extremely dangerous for the citizens of FL.

Do the right thing and make sure that any plans to extend the operating life of Turkey Point must include concrete measures to address both the water contamination and threats from sea level rise and storm surge to protect Biscayne National Park and the health of surrounding communities and natural areas. Otherwise, the plant's cooling canals should be decommissioned and replaced with alternate cooling technology, such as mechanical draft cooling towers. Thank you.
