SUMMARY

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) continued monitoring the licensee's performance by conducting an Emergency Preparedness Biennial Exercise Inspection at Three Mile Island Unit 1 in accordance with the Reactor Oversight Process. The Reactor Oversight Process is the NRC's program for overseeing the safe operation of commercial nuclear power reactors. INSPECTION SCOPES

Inspections were conducted using the appropriate portions of the inspection procedures (IPs) in effect at the beginning of the inspection unless otherwise noted. Currently approved IPs with their attached revision histories are located on the public website at http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/insp-manual/inspection-procedure/index.html. Samples were declared complete when the IP requirements most appropriate to the inspection activity were met consistent with Inspection Manual Chapter (IMC) 2515, "Light-Water Reactor Inspection Program - Operations Phase." The inspectors reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel to assess licensee performance and compliance with Commission rules and regulations, license conditions, site procedures, and standards.

REACTOR SAFETY

71114.01 - Exercise Evaluation

Inspection Review (IP Section 02.01-02.11) (1 Sample)

The inspectors evaluated the biennial emergency plan exercise. The exercise scenario simulated a train derailment, a reactor coolant system leak near the 'A' reactor coolant pump, and a leak into the auxiliary building from the letdown line on May 7.

Inspection Review (IP Section 02.01-02.03) (1 Sample)

The inspectors verified that there were no changes made to the emergency plan, Emergency Action Levels, or lower-tier implementing procedures for the time period reviewed, October 2018 through May 2019.

Inspection Review (IP Section 02.01 - 02.04) (1 Sample)

The inspectors reviewed and evaluated the proposed scenario for biennial emergency plan exercise on April 3.
