Dear Ms. Kalajainen:

By letter dated January 14, 2019 (ML19023A356), Lawrence & Memorial Hospital (LM) submitted a request for consent to an indirect license transfer of NRC Materials License No. 06-09261-01 to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). Based on the information provided in the January 14, 2019 letter, the NRC understands that Yale New Haven Health Services Corporation (YNHHS) became the sole corporate member of Lawrence & Memorial Corporation (LMC) via a membership substitution transaction. LMC remains the sole corporate parent of LM. As such, control of LM was indirectly transferred to YNHHS. We further understand that this transfer will not result in any changes to the licensee name, licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, location of use, or persons responsible for the radiation safety program.

This was effectively a request for post-hoc approval of an indirect license transfer that occurred on September 8, 2016, without receiving written consent from the Commission. The NRC conducted an inspection at the New London and Waterford, Connecticut, locations on October 17-18, 2018. The inspector determined that an indirect transfer of control had occurred without notification and prior to receiving written consent from the Commission in accordance with 10 CFR 30.34(b)(1), and cited this as a Severity Level IV violation.


As more fully detailed in the enclosed Safety Evaluation Report, which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, and in accordance with 10 CFR 30.34, the NRC consents to the transfer. Please note that since this transaction occurred on September 8, 2016, no other action is required. Future changes in the licensee's name, licensed use, licensed materials, licensed location, persons responsible for licensed material, or other changes to the corporate organizational structure require submission of a request to amend the license or a request to transfer the license. NRC approval must be received prior to implementation of the proposed change.
