Dear Mr. Williams:

Enclosed is a copy of the revisions to the proposed Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality, Title 252, Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC), Chapter 410, Radiation Management rules. The proposed revisions will be made available for public comment on August 15, 2019, with a request for comments in a thirty (30) day period. We request NRC's comments within sixty (60) days of receipt. The proposed regulations are identified by line-in/line-out text and correspond to the following equivalent amendments to NRC's regulations.

A revision is being made to better organize, clarify, and update the regulations in OAC 252:410 10-32 [10 CFR Part 32]. The renaming of subparts C and D and the movement of Sec. 32.72 and 32.74 from subpart B to subpart C. These two sections are being moved because they do not cover generally licensed items.

A revision is being made to OAC 252:410-1-7(a) [10 CFR]. The incorporation by reference date is being changed from January 1, 2016 to January 1, 2019.



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We believe that adoption of these revisions satisfies the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200.
