Dear Ms. Hammond:

In accordance with radioactive materials license number 17-29441-01, Condition 15, ARS International, LLC (ARS) is notifying your office of its intent to resume decommissioning activities at a temporary job site at Robins Air Force Base in Warner Robins, Georgia. ARS and its wholly owned subsidiary, ARS Aleut Remediation, LLC (AAR), will resume radiological activities associated with the completion of decommissioning and final status survey of Building 181. Mobilization for this next phase will begin within the next 14 days.

AAR will perform these activities in accordance with ARS's radioactive materials license 17-29441-01, the previously approved Decommissioning Plan, and the recently approved Decommissioning Plan Addendum. This is a continuation of work activities at Building 181 which began in 2015. ARS/AAR remains a subcontractor to Geosyntec Consultants, Inc. Geosyntec is under contract to the United States Air Force (USAF) to perform decommissioning, MARSSIM final status surveys, and affiliated activities at Building 181.

Both the Decommissioning Plan Addendum and Phase 1 Final Status Survey Report have been reviewed extensively by the US NRC. The NRC has documented its review in the Safety Evaluation Report for the Robins project that is posted in ADAMS.

Attached is notification of a resumption of decommissioning and final status survey activities at our Robins Air Force Base project. This notice is intended to provide continuing information on the status of the project which will enter its second phase within the next 14 days. The project has been extensively reviewed by the NRC throughout the performance of the Phase 1 activities including decommissioning, final status survey, report development, and the development of the addendum to the approved Decommissioning Plan, referred to as the Phase 2 addendum. Phase 2 involves the limited demolition of the concrete floors and apron followed by abatement of asbestos and the continued characterization and final status survey of a sub-grade basement and pipe chase identified during Phase 1. Dr. Robert Evans with your office has been extensively involved in the development and review of these documents, including our latest project status call conducted yesterday.
