Enclosed is a copy of the revisions to the proposed Georgia Rules and Regulations for Radioactive Materials (Georgia Rules Chapter 391-3-17). The proposed revisions will be made available for public comment after the Georgia Department of Natural Resources Board of Directors meets and approves the revisions in October 2019. The comment period will remain open for thirty (30) days. We request NRC's comments by July 12, 2019. The proposed rule changes (titled "2019-draft Radioactive Materials Rulebook 06-04-19.docx") have been made using underlines and strikethroughs and have been highlighted for ease in finding changes. I have enclosed documents titled "2018-1-Georgia Updates" and "2013-2-Georgia Updates" using the NRC Regulation Amendment Tracking System sheets to provide a comparison between NRC Regulations and the corresponding Georgia Rule. Additionally, a summary crosswalk table (titled "Ga Rule Revisions 2019 for NRC.xlsx") is included for easier reference.
