Dear Dr. Fink-Bennett:

We have reviewed your amendment request dated May 24, 2019 requesting to name a new Radiation Safety Officer (RSO), Ms. Sheila Shaffer and proposing an Associate Radiation Safety Officer (ARSO) for medical use, Dr. Janice M. Campbell. Based on the review, we will need the following information.

- 1) A copy of the delegation of authority for RSO for Ms. Shaffer. A sample is attached for your reference.
- 2) Please specify the modalities listed in 10 CFR 35 and are authorized in your license (such as 10 CFR 35.100, 35.200, 35.300, 35.400, 35.600 (limited to the IR-192 in the HDRs), and 35.1000 (limited to Y-90 as TheraSpheres and Sir-Spheres microspheres)) which will be assigned to the proposed ARSO, Dr. Campbell.

To continue the review of your amendment request, we request that you submit a written response to this letter by July 26, 2019. Your response must be dated and signed by a licensee's representative and please reference Mail Control Number 612373 in the response. To expedite the licensing process, you could fax your response to 630-515-1078. Model Delegation of Authority to RSO

Memo To: Radiation Safety Officer
From: Chief Executive Officer (or designee)
Subject: Delegation of Authority

You, _____, have been appointed radiation safety officer and are responsible for ensuring the safe and secure use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the Radiation Protection Program, identifying radiation protection problems, initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions, verifying implementation of corrective actions, stopping unsafe activities, and ensuring compliance with regulations. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations, when justified, to maintain radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff does not cooperate and does not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission at any time. It is estimated that you will spend _____ hours per week conducting radiation protection activities.
