Dear Sir or Madam:

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(q), Southern California Edison (SCE) has revised the Permanently Defueled Emergency Plan Emergency Action Level Technical Bases Manual and one Permanently Defueled Emergency Plan Implementing Procedure (EPIP) for the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS). This letter serves as the report required by 10 CFR 50.54(q)(5).

SCE has determined that the changes do not reduce the effectiveness of the Permanently Defueled Emergency Plan (PDEP) or Permanently Defueled EIPs. The PDEP, as changed, continues to meet the standards of 10 CFR 50.47(b) and the requirements of 10 CFR 50 Appendix E (as exempted).

Attachment 1 of this letter transmits Revision 4 of the SONGS Permanently Defueled Emergency Plan Emergency Action Level Technical Bases Manual effective June 6, 2019.

Attachment 2 provides a report and analysis summary of the Permanently Defueled Emergency Plan Emergency Action Level Technical Bases Manual changes.
