(U) On June 13, 2019, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security inspection at your Watts Bar Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. The inspector discussed the results of this inspection with R. Staggs and other members of your staff. The results of this inspection are documented in the enclosed report.

(U) No NRC-identified or self-revealing findings were identified during this inspection. However, a licensee-identified violation which was determined to be of very low security significance is documented in this report. We are treating this violation as a non-cited violation (NCV) consistent with Section 2.3.2.a of the Enforcement Policy.
