Dear NRC:

Edison has presented conflicting and confusing statements about their use of the funds collected for decommissioning. I submit that they are tearing down, storing and attempting to dispose of the wreckage from RSGs 2 and 3 at their San Onofre plant (SONGS) as a result of their self-caused misfortune resulting in the cessation of operation. I submit that the costs of their misfortune must not be borne by ratepayers.

This petition from Energy Solutions (below) asks for release of funds "BEFORE permanent cessation of operation". SONGS has ceased operation. Please confirm that this petition will not allow Edison to use funds from the decommissioning fund, and that, in any case, Edison may not use such funds for their clearance of the wreckage from SONGS.

Energy Solutions is a contractor to Edison.

Edison initially promised that ratepayers would not have to pay for faulty RSGs. They booked 6 or 7 billion dollars in their annual report for 'decommissioning'.

SUMMARY:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has received a petition for rulemaking from Gerard P. Van Noordennen on behalf of EnergySolutions, LLC, dated February 22, 2019. The petitioner requests that the NRC revise its regulations to allow access to the decommissioning trust fund for the removal of major radioactive components before the permanent cessation of operations. The petition was docketed by the NRC on March 20, 2019 and has been assigned Docket No. PRM-50-119. The NRC is examining the issues raised in PRM-50-119 to determine whether they should be considered in rulemaking. The NRC is requesting public comment on this petition at this time.

DATES:

Submit comments by August 26, 2019. Comments received after this date will be considered if it is practical to do so, but the NRC is able to assure consideration only for comments received on or before this date.
