# EPG/SAG Rev 4 Implementation Activities



- **NRC access to materials:**
  - NRC Headquarters and the Technical Training Center (TTC) had access to and reviewed EPG/SAG Rev 4 (note - access to documents ended in late June 2019)
  - Any comments submitted to the EPC from this review will be addressed in the same manner as other fleet issues:
    - ✓ Assigned to an individual or group (perhaps with contractor support)
    - ✓ Solutions identified, discussed with fleet / stake holder and action(s) taken to resolve issue
    - ✓ Resolved issue documented and provided for fleet implementation as appropriate
