
Dear Mr. Chairman:

The Environment, Energy and Natural Resources Subcommittee of the House Committee on Government Operations, pursuant to its general oversight and investigative authority under clauses 2 and 4 of Rule X and clause 1 of Rule XI of the House of Representatives, respectfully requests that you provide it with verbatim transcripts of all closed meetings of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission at which the Three Mile Island incident has been discussed, including but not limited to the transcripts of the meeting which took place on or about Saturday, March 31, 1979, at which the decision was made to close this series of meetings. I understand that the Commission's General Counsel has advised my Subcommittee Counsel that some of this material has not yet been transcribed from tape recordings made at the meetings. While the Subcommittee at this time is requesting only the "hard" (typed) transcripts, and not the tapes, please consider this a continuing request for the typed transcription of each tape as it becomes available. As to those typed transcripts which now exist, the Subcommittee would appreciate receiving them by c.o.b. Monday, April 9, 1979, in the Subcommittee offices at B-371-B Rayburn House Office Building.

This request is properly within the jurisdiction of the Committee on Government Operations, as granted it by Rule X of the House of Representatives, and of this Subcommittee, as delegated to it by Rule 8 of the Rules of the Committee on Government Operations and by the actions taken by the Committee on Government Operations at its organizational meeting for the Ninety-Sixth Congress on February 1, 1979.
