MEMORANDUM

The Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Licensing Board) in this proceeding, by initial decision dated October 31, 1969, has authorized the issuance of a provisional construction permit to the applicants for a pressurized water reactor facility to be located on Three Mile Island in the Susquehanna River in Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.

Pursuant to § 2.785 (a)(1) of its Rules of Practice, 10 CFR Part 2, the Commission has delegated to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board (Appeal Board) the authority and review function which would otherwise be exercised and performed by the Commission in this proceeding.


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No exceptions to the initial decision have been filed by any party to the proceeding, the time for such filing having expired on November 20, 1969.

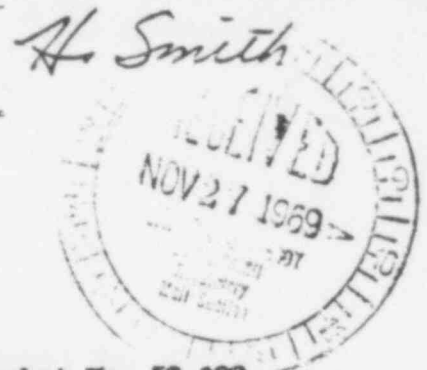
