Mr. Brown,

We noticed that a management representative did not sign the May 6, 2019, license amendment request. When submitting future license amendments, please have the document signed by a management representative rather than the Radiation Safety Officer. The NRC views a letter signed by a management representative as indication that management has reviewed the application and concurs in the statements and representations contained therein. In addition, please note that NRC Form 313 requires the applicant, by signature, to verify that the applicant understands that all statements contained in the application are true and correct to the best of the applicant's knowledge. The signatory for the application should be the licensee or a certifying official of the licensee rather than a consultant.

To correct this, please draft a letter and have your President or Chief Financial Officer sign the letter which states that they approve of the May 5, 2019, license amendment request to add 515 Camden Street, Parkersburg, WV 26101 as a location of use and storage to your NRC License.
