This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. D. Donaldson of this office on September 21 and 22, 1977, at the Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Units 1 and 2, of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. DPR-50 and CPPR-66, and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Donaldson with Mr. J. Seelinger and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Office of Inspection and Enforcement Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you had taken to correct the items of noncompliance brought to your attention in a letter dated July 12, 1977. We have no further questions regarding your actions for items A and B at this time.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
