This refers to the inspection conducted by W. H. Miller, Jr. of this office on June 5-8, 1979 of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. DPR-32 and DPR-37 for the Surry Power Station facility, Units 1 and 2, and to the discussion of our findings held with W. L. Steward at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these a as, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were disclosed.

We have examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified enforcement matters and unresolved items. The status of these items is discussed in the enclosed report.

Two new unresolved items resulted from this inspection and are discussed in the enclosed report. These items will be examined during subsequent inspections.
