



concluded that the structural design and fabrication of the high-density spent fuel storage racks are acceptable (SE, §§2.2, 2.3). Further, the installation and interim use of the high-density racks under the conditions described in the motion do not affect contentions which remain in issue in the proceeding. Accordingly, the Staff supports the motion.

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
