Swanson of this office on June 26 and 27, 1979, of activities at Point Beach Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1 and 2, authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DPR-24 and No. DPR-27 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. G. A. Reed at the conclusion of the inspection.
