Subject: Import of Enriched UF₆ Gas

Please grant us an import license for the following special nuclear material being imported from France.

Westinghouse will purchase for use in Westinghouse nuclear power plants 1300 Kgs. of uranium from AGIP Nucleare SpA located in Milan, Italy.

The uranium will be supplied in the form of UF₆ gas and shall be enriched up to 3.3 weight percent of the isotope U-235.

42.9 Kgs
U-235

The material is located in EURODIF enriching facility in Tricastin, France and will be exported from France to the United States.

Delivery of the UF₆ gas is expected to begin in January 1980 and extend through June 31, 1981.

Shipping containers which will be used for transporting this material will be type 30A UF₆ cylinders.

All of the above material will be delivered to the Westinghouse facility located in Columbia, South Carolina.

The approximate value for the total order is one million U.S. dollars.

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
