SUBJECT: FACILITY BRIEFING PACKAGES FOR INCIDENT RESPONSE
PROGRAM

Our respective staffs have been working together along with NRR to improve the NRC capability to respond to various types of incidents involving licensees and licensed activities. A memorandum from Harry Thornburg to Dick Cunningham dated September 30, 1976 (copy enclosed) tasked NMSS to prepare plant and site specific information packages for fuel and materials licensees as agreed by the Joint Incident Response Task Force. As a result of the memorandum, we have had several meetings to further develop the details of that request. However, little progress has been made.

We are bringing this matter to your attention because the recent Ft. St. Vrain incident has demonstrated that there is an urgent need to more fully develop the NRC Incident Response capability. The information which was requested in the September 30, 1976 memorandum is still needed for the Incident Response Center. Therefore, I would appreciate your response as to the feasibility of our request and your anticipated completion date for this task.
