On or about the first of May 1979, a private company (Rickano Corp.) submitted an application to the Kansas Dept. of Health and Environment requesting authorization to store Low Level wastes in the abandoned Carey salt mine in Rice County.

I would like all documents, memos, letters, etc. including both applications sent to your office or any other in the NRC from Kansas and anything sent to Kansas concerning the proposed site in Lyons. In short, every scrap of paperwork that exists concerning Rickano's proposal.

I am aware that such an undertaking will require some time and am not insensitive to possible costs that may be incurred. I am perfectly willing to pay a fee for the requested material.
