
Dear Mr. Kammerer:

I am writing you in order to obtain information on behalf of a constituent regarding the proposed dumping of water containing low-level radioactive waste into the Susquehanna River.

First, would you tell me if your agency or any other agency is monitoring or overseeing the current dumping of industrial waste water from Unit 1 at Three Mile Island and in the event that any other water is dumped in the future, what provisions for on-going monitoring and oversight have been made. Second, please inform me about specific radioactive wastes for which your agency or other agencies are conducting tests to determine presence in the waste water.
