I hearby request personal access to any information including reports, memorandums, and depositions, filed at the recent public hearings in Cincinnati on the Zimmer nuclear power plant, by workers (including sub-contracted work) of the plant relating to safety hezards surrounding plant construction. I request this information under 5U.S.C. 552 et seq., The Freedom of Information Act.

Specifically documents and statements filed by Ed Hofstadtler, former employee of Husky-Burndy Co., suppliers to Zimmer and Thomas Martin, a worker at the plant sight. Also responses to charges from company officials at CG&E, owners of the plant.

If you agree to this request in whole or part, please forward copies of the requested items with a bill fo- copy and search fees, not to exceed \$20. If the remaining items exceed the amount of \$20, please inform me of the ballance.

If any part of this request is denied, please inform me of your appeal procedures. I will consider my request denied if I have no communication from you within 12 working days.

Please be put on notice that I consider this information clearly releasable under the Freedom of Information Act and that I consider a refusal to release the information to be arbitrary and capriceds as defined in the Act.
