Dear Mr. Peterson:

Babcock & Wilcox Company hereby requests a license for the importation of low enriched uranium. The material will be in the form of gadolinium oxide/uranium dioxide (Gd 203-UO2) pellets, and comprise up to 1000 Kilograms uranium containing up to 40 Kilograms U-235 at a maximum enrichment of 4.05%.

Reaktor Brennelement Union GmbH in Hanau, West Germany will be requested to supply the feed material and fabricate the gadolinia pellets under purchase order to B&W requirements. The pellets will be imported into the United States for use in one of B&W's commercial nuclear power plants.


Imported material will be shipped in USA/5442/A ( )F, USA/5768/B ( )F, or USA/6294/AF type packages to B&W facilities in Apollo, Pennsylvania and Lynchburg, Virginia.

Please note that we anticipate that the material will be imported between the dates of July 1, 1980 and June 1, 1983, and ask that the import license remain valid during that time.
